LUPO Wolf Sanctuary

The Call of Nature

A one-of-a-kind project in North America, LUPO is the first wolf education and observation center on the continent to offer outdoor activities year-round. LUPO offers an immersive experience to learn about wolves and reconnect with nature.

Languages: English, French and Italian

Suggested Activities:

VIP Guided Tour and 'Sleep with the Wolves' Accommodation.

Duration: 60 to 75 mins

- Outdoor Amphitheater and marquee with capacity for up to 300 people
- Parking for 10 to 15 buses.

Grosse Île and The Irish Memorial National Historic Site

Grosse Île is a captivating National Historic Site that offers a powerful journey through time. Once a quarantine station, it bears witness to the arrival of tens of thousands of immigrants to Canada between 1832 and 1937. Rich in history and emotion, Grosse-Île remains one of Quebec's most fascinating hidden treasures.

Languages: English and French

Suggested Activities: Guided Tour and Sarah Wade Medical Inspection.

Duration: About 6 hours

The highlights:

- A site rich in history, brought to life by exceptional guides.
- Just steps from the boarding dock, L'Amiral restaurant offers a terrace with stunning river views.

Expedition to the Secret Islands of the Saint Lawrence

Bistreau d'érable

A Deep-Rooted Family Tradition

Le Bistreau d'érable is a family-run sugar shack where maple syrup and related products are made. Enjoy a guided tour, a traditional meal, reinvented dishes made with local ingredients, and the legendary sugar party featuring maple taffy on snow!

Languages: English and French

Suggested Activities: Guided Tour about maple exploitation and taffy on snow.

Duration: 2 hours

Highlights: Restaurant for 45 people.

Domaine Ritt

At the Heart of the Apple Route

A creator of flavors, Domaine Ritt practices sustainable management of its orchards. Domaine Ritt features 4,000 apple trees, produces 20,000 liters of cider annually, and is led by a committed apple grower: Jean-François Ritt.

Languages: English and French

Suggested Activities: Guided tour and tasting of 6 products as well as 2 alcohol-free products.

Duration: 30 min to 1 hour

Domaine des Feux Follets is home to a historic barn surrounded by 9,300 grapevines. Run by a passionate couple, the winery specializes in natural wines.

Languages: English and French

Suggested Activities: Guided tour and tasting of 4 products.

Duration: 2 hours

Highlights: Large welcoming area, possibility of having artists on site.

The Accordion Museum

A Living Heritage

In 2021, Quebec's Ministry of Culture officially recognized the diatonic accordion as a vital cultural and national identity practice. Join the dance and discover this remarkable instrument along with the many tradition bearers who keep its spirit alive.

Languages: English and French

Suggested Activities: Guided tour; possibility of a private concert with an accordionist (additional cost).

Duration: 1 hour 15 minutes + 35 minutes private concert

Highlights: The private concert can also take place at a partner's home or in a lodging establishment. An international festival is held every year on Labor Day.

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Sir Étienne-Paschal-Taché House

A Testament to Canadian History

The Sir Étienne-Paschal-Taché National Historic Site features an exhibition dedicated to the life and legacy of Sir Étienne-Paschal Taché, one of the Fathers of Canadian Confederation. Carefully restored, the house stands as a treasured historical legacy.

Languages: English and French

Suggested Activity: Guided Tour

Duration: 1 hr 30 mins

Highlights: Ideally located for exploring the heart of Old Montmagny.

Open May to October



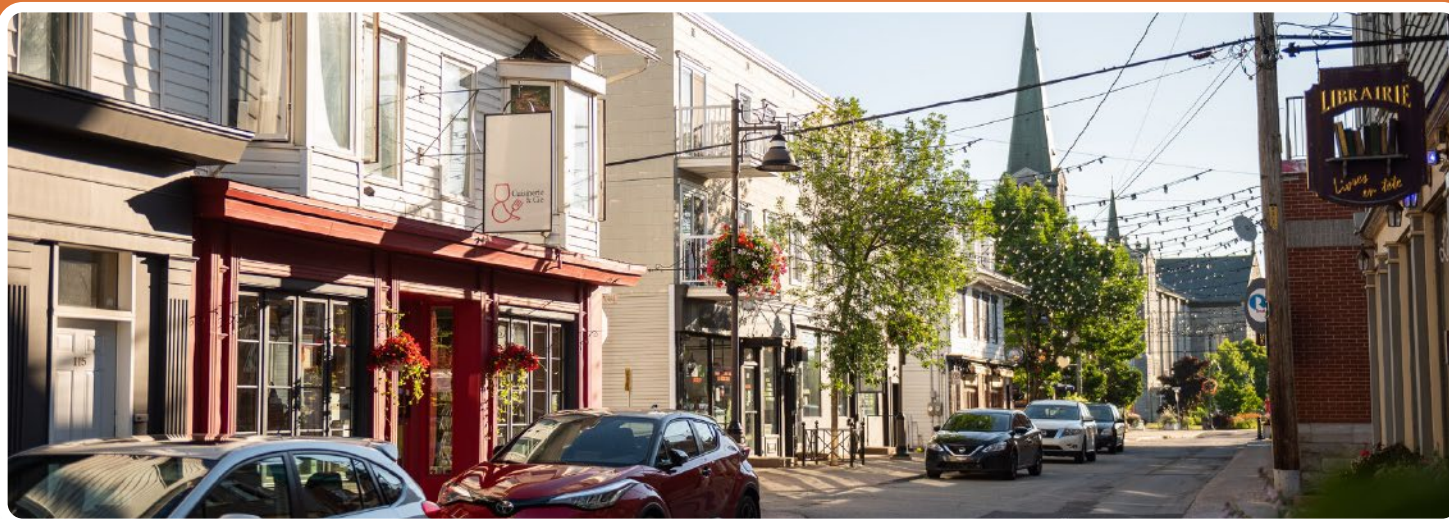
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Downtown Montmagny
